In fact, all across the country, our Elmcroft and Embark communities are revitalizing and thriving as we begin to come out of the pandemic. Dining rooms are re-opening, groups activities are re-starting, and more and more families and friends are getting opportunities to see their loved ones in-person.

And I will say, nothing has been more rewarding and inspiring as seeing images of grandchildren hugging their grandparents again thanks to being vaccinated. It's an image I'm looking forward to seeing in my own family once my son gets his vaccine this weekend.

### The Pace and Path Ahead

We are so pleased with the hundreds of vaccination clinics we have hosted in our communities across the country these past few months. The clinics were a tremendous success, resulting in 80% of all residents and 58% of all associates being fully vaccinated. Now, with the vaccine becoming more accessible to more people, we believe these numbers will grow further as the vaccine continues to be proven safe and effective.

Think of this:

- Nearly 20% of Americans are now fully vaccinated for COVID-19
- About 55% of Americans aged 65 or better are now fully vaccinated for COVID-19
- Our country is now delivering more than 3 million COVID-19 vaccine shots a day, and this continues to grow
- In ongoing studies, the Pfizer vaccine remains 91% effective for at least six months according to the company; and the CDC says it's 100% effective at preventing severe disease.

- More recently, a small trial concluded the vaccine is 100% effective with children aged 12-15. Moderna is viewed as effective as Pfizer by the CDC, given their similar make-ups.

It's with all of that in mind we continue to ask associates in our communities to be fully vaccinated by June. Vaccination and the process of immunization is a proven science – and this critical additional precaution will better protect the health of our communities. We strongly encourage visitors to get the vaccine as well.

In closing, I again want to thank each and every one of you for your ongoing patience, vigilance and resilience. The past year was unlike any other, but Spring is here, the world is back in bloom, and thanks to your efforts and the vaccines, brighter days are ahead. Days where we can connect with one another socially, hug loved ones without fear, and simply get back to the things we enjoy.
